THE ROTARY CLUB OF VININGS COMMUNITY SERVICE 1990-91

The committees under the community service area had a very busy and successful year in 1990-91. The following were undertaken and completed with great success.

GOLF TOURNAMENT

In April 1990, the Rotary Club of Vinings held its first Golf Tournament at the Pinetree Country Club in Atlanta to raise money for the Calvary Children's Home. After expenses, the Club presented Snyder Turner, Administrator of the Calvary Children's Home, with a check in the amount of \$2,000.00.

COMPUTER FOR LEARNING

With weekly Kroger grocery receipts contributed from club members over a six month period, the Rotary Club of Vinings accumulated over \$200,000.00 in receipts required to qualify for a free IBM computer that was donated to the Calvary Children's Home.

OPENING OF VININGS LIBRARY

The new Vinings library was opened in August, 1990. Members of the Vinings Rotary helped coordinate the festivities and refreshments that were served to over 200 people including residents, county commissioners, and local representatives.

BOY SCOUTS

In the early part of 1991, the Club donated \$100.00 to the annual fund drive for the local Cobb County District of the Boy Scouts.

BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB

\$500.00 was donated to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Atlanta through the Jessie Draper Owens Club of East Point.

LANDSCAPING THE VININGS LIBRARY

The County does not budget for the landscaping of their library facilities. Therefore, the Rotary Club of Vinings set up a booth during the local Vinings Fall Festival and sold apples, cheese and sandwiches to raise money for the landscaping of the Vinings Library. Irrigation pipes were laid and landscaping plans were drawn. The actual beautification plan became a reality in the spring of 1991 when a number of club members spent a Saturday tilling, raking, planting and generally landscaping the library grounds according to the plan.

We are all very proud of the hard working committees in the community service area who's tireless efforts made many good plans come to life this year.
